# JOB COMPLETED BY CITY ENGINEER

Mammoth Task of Renaming Certain Streets of Salt Lake.

### BE CALLED AVENUES.

All Duplications in Names Are to be Done Away With-Up to the Council.

The mammoth task of renaming certain streets of the city as authorized by the city council so as to avoid duplication of names in various parts of the city, has been completed by City Engineer Kelsey who has prepared a report and map showing the old and new names where changes have been made. The report will be submitted to the city council on Monday night and will probably be approved and a resolution adopted confirming the new names. The general provision of the report is that all streets running east and west and less than 132 feet wide shall be designated as avenues: all duplications in names are done away with; all continuations of streets bearing different names from the original streets are given the same name as the streets of which they are entinuations; all streets on the north continuations; all streets on the north bench running east and west are des-ignated as avenues, such as First avenue. Second avenue, etc. Follow-ing is the list of changes proposed by the engineer, the second name being the new name proposed in each in-
