YOUNG HOLLANDER SERIOUSLY HURT.

J. H. Winslow Jr. Found Guilty—Little
LeRoy Petty Dead—Baby Falls
From Buggy.

Ogden, Utah, April 11.—A young Hollander boy named Henry Kouw, who has been in this country only a few months, met with painful injuries last evening about 8 o'clock, near the corner of Washington avenue and Twenty-fifth street, which will lay him up for some time.

Henry, who is about 13 years of age, was riding a bicycle down Twenty-fifth street high when he lost control of it, and dashed down onto Washington avenue at rapid speed. The bicycle collided with a heavy job wagon with great force, throwing the rider to the pavement under the wagon. One wheel passed over his chest before the team could be stopped, and the force of the fall bruised his body, and cut several gashes on his face and head and legs. He was picked up in a dazed condition and carried into Culley's drug store, where Dr. A. H. Hissell, who has been in Ogden several days, examined him. It was necessary to put several stitches in two of the wounds, one on the chin and one on the leg, to close them up, and while it is uncertain if the wound on the chin will heal, the doctor does not believe that he has, and is of the opinion that he will be out again in a week's time. J. H. WINSLOW JR., FOUND GUILTY.

J. H. Winslow, Jr., was last evening found guilty of attending incest with his own daughter. The case has been before Judge Howell and a jury during the past three days. He was charged with incest in the complaint, but the verdict was attorney incest and Wednesday he will appear for sentence. The crime was committed nearly two years ago on his little 12-year-old daughter. Her mother was also a witness against her now divorced husband. Chief of Police Browning, Capt. Brown and Officer Robert Burke testified to the arrest of the defendant, and of his admission of having attempted the crime.

Mr. Winslow, however, went on the witness stand in his own behalf and denied that he had broken down. He denied having made confessions of his guilt to the officers.

The case was submitted to the jury last evening at 3 o'clock after lengthy arguments by Dist. Atty. Halverson for the state and H. H. Henderson for the defendant. The jury was nearly four hours before being able to agree on a verdict. Winslow is a man about 38 years of age.

LEROY PETTY OF STATE SCHOOL DEAD.

At 12:30 yesterday afternoon death claimed LeRoy Petty, an inmate of the State School for the Deaf and Blind, the immediate cause of death being a heart attack, from which he had suffered for several months past, but was only taken ill with the last attack five days ago. Everything that could do to save the boy's life was tried, but the inevitable could not be averted. He had been a student at the school in the deaf department during the past two years, very bright and apt to learn, and a favorite with his fellow students. His body was removed to Larkin & Son's undertaking parlors where it was embalmed and will be taken to his home at Sterling, Kane county, Utah, where his father, George Petty, will accompany the remains. LeRoy was the son of Mrs. Margie Petty. He was born at Ferron, Emery county, Utah, Oct. 25, 1897.

BABY FALLS FROM BUGGY.

The little two-year-old babe of Mrs. Clair Wareham narrowly escaped losing his right eye yesterday by falling from the baby carriage. The baby had against a sharp iron. Mrs. Wareham was out shopping and had the baby in the buggy in front of Christensen's shoe store. While her attention was directed to the show window, the baby reached out of the buggy and became over balanced, falling head-first on the iron railing in front of the store. The mother quickly clasped the child in her arms and ran to Dr. Powers' office. The doctor washed the blood which oozed from a deep gash in the child's right eye. He had to put three stitches in the wound to close it. The child will carry a scar for a long time from the injury.
