ANNUAL REPORT ON INDIAN AFFAIRS

Commissioner Has Much to Say Relative to Work Last Year.

THE UTAH RESERVATION.

An Example of Rushing and Haphazard Method—Two General Ways of Making Allotments.

Special Correspondence.

Washington, D. C.—The commissioner of Indian affairs in his annual report has this to say relative to work on the Utah reservation last year: "Utah.—There are two general methods of making allotments. The one is merely to schedule such names as may be readily found on the agency rolls and list a tract of land opposite each name, not only without running the lines and establishing the corners, but even without any information as to the character of the land or its location with regard to the allottee's home or selection. The other requires the running out of the survey lines and establishing the corners in the presence of the selector. It sometimes occurs that land actually wanted, and which ought to be allotted, is entirely different from that which seemed to be indicated by the description given. Too often the specific legislation directing the opening of a reservation seems to contain the elements of confusion and is hurried through after the first plan.
