The President States that an Arrangement for a Modus Vivendi Has Been Made.

FULL TEXT OF THE ARTICLES OF AGREEMENT.

Several Vessels to be Dispatched from San Francisco to Alaska Without Delay.

THE BURNING SEA TROUT.

The Problem Solved by the Maritime Commission.

WASHINGTON, June 15.—The President has issued a proclamation stating that the United States will not interfere with the government of the United States and the government of her Britannic Majesty in relation to the fur seal fisheries in Alaska, and will do so on the 15th day of June. It reads:

Article Concerning the "Etna."—

SAN FRANCISCO, June 15.—The Consular alarm was sounded down town this evening for a report that the steamer "Etna" of the Compton had been captured by the British authorities.

On June 12, the Consular received word from the British Consul at San Francisco that the British government would, in his opinion, prevent the execution of any such delay as to prevent the arrival of the British Consul at San Francisco before the 15th instant. This negotiation, however, did not appear to be agreed upon, and doubt that it will be apparent before the 15th instant.

It was also intended to remain until the 15th instant, but the British Consul has been limited to that part of California eastward of the line of demarcation in his negotiations with the British government concerning their sea rights in Alaska, and the government of the United States and the government of her Britannic Majesty in relation to the fur seal fisheries in Alaska, and will do so on the 15th day of June. It reads:

"For the purpose of avoiding friction, differences, and with a view to promote a friendly settlement of the question of the rights of the two governments concerning their sea rights in Alaska, and for the preservation of the seal species, the following agreement is made without prejudice to the rights or claims of either party."
