Governor Richards, of Montana, has

fortified by preclusion in the importation of sheep into Montana from Oregon, Nevada, California, Washington, Wyoming, Idaho, Colorado, Utah and New Mexico, because of the reported prevalence of scab in the flocks of these states. Sheep from the localities mentioned may be brought

into Montana upon the certificate of the state veterinarian or his duly authorized deputy, that such sheep have been inspected or have been found to be free from scab or any infectious or contagious diseases. Carriers, persons and companies must give notice to the state veterinarian.

domestic animals, preventing the arrival at the boundary line of Montana, of all such sheep as come within the provisions of the proclamation. Nothing in the proclamation shall be so construed as to prohibit the transportation of any sheep through the state by rail, or which sheep do not cross within said state.
