

M'PARLAND IS CROSS EXAMINED

Atty. Darrow Goes Into His Life From Birth to Arrest of Steve Adams.

HE GOT MANY CONFESSIONS.

Defendant's Counsel Tried to Show That Client Had Been Promised Clemency.

SPOKANE, Wash., Nov. 13.—A special to the *Spokane Review* from Raindrum, Idaho, says:

Progress in the trial of Steve Adams, a member of the Western Federation of Miners, who is on trial here for the alleged murder of Fred Tyler, in the Marble Creek district of Shoshone county, Idaho, in August, 1904, was delayed this afternoon through a desire of Clarence Darrow, chief counsel for Adams, to go to Spokane and have a specialist examine his right ear.

The costly examination was taken today in a cross-examination of James McParland, Mr. Darrow's chief witness, by the defense. The history of McParland, following it from his birth to the time of the arrest of Steve Adams, McParland said he went to work for the Pinkerton agency about 1880, and has been with it ever since, becoming superintendent of the Denver office in 1887, and about 1892 becoming president of the Colorado division.

He said he had gained many confessions from men, both inside and outside of prisons, and told of a number obtained fronts.

In eliciting these confessions, McParland told the men the state as a rule dealt liberally with men who turned state's evidence, and that he was a member of this order for two years and a half for the purpose of obtaining evidence against them, and that as a result of his investigations 18 men were hanged, and later five or six more were hanged.

During the cross-examination, Mr. Hawley entered vigorous objection, but they were overruled, the court stating that he proposed to be more liberal than usual in this case. Considerable animosity was exhibited by both Mr. Hawley and Mr. Darrow, and they were reprimanded by the court. They then apologized to the court and to each other.

McParland had testified that he was a native of Ireland, and when asked if the Molly Maguires were the Ancient Order of Hibernians, replied shortly, "No, it was a criminal organization."

"Was it a secret organization?" asked Darrow.

"It was a secret criminal organization," said McParland.

"Did you go by your own name?"

"I went by the name of James McKenna."

Hawley interposed an objection, and it was sustained.

Going to the Adams confession, Mr. Darrow said that he had heard from McParland that he had told Adams stories of characters redeemed after having served long terms, and that he knew of criminals who had not been prosecuted after turning state's evidence, like Kelly the bum, who peached on the Molly Maguires.

He then asked:

"So you told him of Bible characters to impress him of his soul's safety, and like Kelly the bum to insure him that his body would be safe?" asked Darrow.

"I told him that the state most always helped men who acted fairly with it," replied McParland.

The state is put the testimony is person of William B. Chandler, who was writing a history about the time of the Taos Million dollar fire in the Creek district, and who has fled to Butte, Mont., fearing that he will meet with foul play should he testify against Adams. His testimony, taken at Wallace, was introduced through affidavit, it being shown that the state's attorney had received a telegram from Chandler that he would not come home. Chandler's testimony supports that of George H. Root of Wallace, and Steve Legan, both claim holders, in August, 1904, on Marble Creek, in placing Adams there with Simpkins, Price, Mason, Clover and others.

LABOR FEDERATION ASKS FEDERAL AID

First to Prevent Consumption Of Reciprocity Treaty With Canada.

WANTS JAPANESE EXCLUDED.

Would Stop the Enforcement of Freight Rates on Forest Products Contemplated by Roads.

NORFOLK, Va., Nov. 13.—The fight between the American Federation of Labor and the Manufacturers' association, growing out of the suit brought in the District of Columbia by James W. Van Cleef, president of the association for the antitrust injunction desired by a St. Louis shoe manufacturing concern, came to an issue before the federation convention today, when the body received and referred to a special committee of 15 resolutions setting forth the fight that is now being waged by the Manufacturers' association practically all of the interests in health of this generation is caused by almost constant conditions.
