

GRAND JURY'S FINAL REPORT.

Full Text of the Document Presented to Judge Zane.

Owing to the late hour at which the grand jury met at the Third District Court, handed in their report yesterday, the News was able to give only a brief synopsis of the same. Below we reproduce the document in full:

To Hon. Charles W. Zane, Judge Third Judicial District Court:

Your grand jury has been called to submit the following report:

On January 22, 1892, the grand jury has continued its charge without interruption, being engaged all day in the examination and service.

During this time it has considered six re-fund cases, fifty-eight of which came from the State of New Mexico, and one from the State of Colorado.

Of this number fifteen have shown sufficient evidence to hold over for trial.

The others were remanded to our opinion and consequently were rejected.

We have examined all the witnesses with whom we were especially charged to make investigation, relating to the grand jury's charge, and have found no evidence or witness as would be most important.

We were unable to make any finding in regard to the charges made by the State of New Mexico.

Much testimony was given as to rumors and current events, but any direct reference to the subject.

Whether this arises from the unwillingness to implicate itself and the evils it apprehended, or the fact that we are unable to find any witness who will corroborate the charges.

The grand jury visited in a body the sheriff, the attorney, the county jail, the city prison and the county courthouse, for the purpose of inspecting the amount of punishment inflicted upon the prisoners in the custody of the sheriff.

In the course of the inquiry the testimony of the inmates of the penitentiary we learn that the institution has improved.

The fact still persists, however, that the institution does not serve altogether the purpose intended.

It is the opinion of the grand jury that the inmates of the prison are given little, though much more would be given them if they were allowed to mingle and converse with each other, and it would seem, according to the facts, that the atmosphere of the prison would apparently improve.

There has been an attempt to manufacture the penitentiary.

A number of trustees were sent to Philadelphia to furnish plans for the chapel, and the ordinary dressings, including a number of services, were performed by the inmates.

However, it is noted, a very marked improvement, suggested by the inmates, is the extension of the building to fit all the purposes.

The main hall is to be used for the dining room, the kitchen, the laundry and the shop, manufacturing solely for the use of the prison and not to compete with the outside trade.

It is the opinion of the grand jury that the penitentiary should be permitted on a large scale.

With these means of employment, more vigorous discipline should be maintained, and a place of punishment instead of recreation and rest.

The authority and responsibility of the warden and his assistants should be increased.

The county jail is to be in accordance with the law, and has no accommodation for men.

The city prison is a pile of odds and ends, and the conditions and arrangements suggest the barbershop of the middle ages, rather than the modern era.

It is the opinion of the grand jury that the county jail should be removed, and the warden and his assistants should be increased.
