

the part of the Lords. The probability is that they will in amendments in the spirit of the amendments of Mr. Heneage and Edmund Fitzmaurice, and to the exclusion of lease holders, but probably accept Heneage's amendment taking the estates, managed on the English system, from the operation of the bill. The bill will be accepted as a nominal compromise, and the bill will be law substantially as it left the Commons. This view of the situation was generally entertained among the members of the lower house last night.

The Herald's London dispatch the following account of the session of Parnell in the House of Commons: Mr. Justin McCarthy called attention to the imprisoned Leaguers, asking for an opportunity to present their case in Parliament. Mr. Gladstone replied, after some delay, that the Irish members would have ample opportunity to discuss arrests on the estate. This reply annoyed Mr. Parnell, who rose and denounced the conduct of the Ministry in continuing to hold Irishmen who were the true authors of the land bill, while at the same time they admitted the justice claims put forth on behalf of the tenant farmers and the absolute necessity of reform. This conduct Mr. Parnell declared the Ministry and the Parliament to be tyrants and oppressors.

Mr. Gladstone and Sir Stafford Northcote rose simultaneously and called the speaker's attention to this language, but Mr. Parnell went on vehemently, paying no attention to the speaker. He declared he cared nothing for the House of Commons. Mr. Gladstone moved his suspension, but before the question could be put, Mr. Parnell said that he would wait to see the farce played out, and then withdrew before his formal suspension, which was carried immediately afterward by an overwhelming majority.

St. Petersburg, I.—It is announced that another plot for the assassination of the Czar has been discovered and frustrated by the police. A high family was chosen as assassin. Her accomplices have been arrested, but she has fled. The Czar and family left Moscow secretly on Sunday for Nyni Novgorod.

This afternoon a hundred cigar makers struck at Detroit, Mich., and work was generally suspended.

The steamers Idlewild and Osceola arrived at Memphis, Sunday evening. Loss \$70,090; insurance light.

The wife of ex-senator Howe, of Wisconsin, died to-day at the residence of her son-in-law, Col. Enoch Allen.

The Papal nuncio at Paris has ordered the clergy not to actively participate in the forthcoming French elections.

A Portland, Oregon, dispatch says: Bishop E. O. Haven, of the M. E. Church, is lying dangerously ill in that city, and not expected to recover.

An Arkansas dispatch says on Saturday last Dallas Rogers shot and killed John Walker for threatening him at his own door. Rogers surrendered.

Chas. Schlifer, of St. Louis, this morning, tried to shoot his mother, then made a murderous assault with hatchet on Louis Graff, and then blew his own brains out.

Hon. Geo. Saulsbury, brother of the United States senator, formerly governor of Delaware, and always a prominent democrat, died in Wilmington yesterday morning.

The amount of 6 per cents continued at 3½ per cent. is \$178,000.

Ex-President Hayes is expected in London late in October, to be present at the ceremony of unveiling the memorial of the late Sir Francis Lytett, which is to be placed in City Road Chapel.

The New York storage and weighing house of W. C. Tilgman, 1 West St., was damaged by fire this morning, to the extent of \$50,000. A number of merchants having goods stored in the building, lose them.

London is crowded with Americans. The hotels are full to overflowing. Labouchere's paper is surprised that some enterprising individual does not build a large hotel and conduct it on the American plan.

The hunt for the Williams brothers has been abandoned. It is thought they escaped from the river several days since. The pursuers were misled by an Indian scout, who is now under arrest for his deception.

Mrs. Ann Simpson, a boarding house keeper, of Detroit, Michigan, died this morning from the effects of a shot fired at her by an unseen hand on Saturday. She charged her husband, who had been separated from her, with the deed.

George Hazell, champion of England, defeated Charles Price, champion, in a ten mile race to-day at the New York Polo grounds. Hazell ran ten miles in 153 minutes and 21½ seconds, and Price in 155 minutes and 5 seconds.

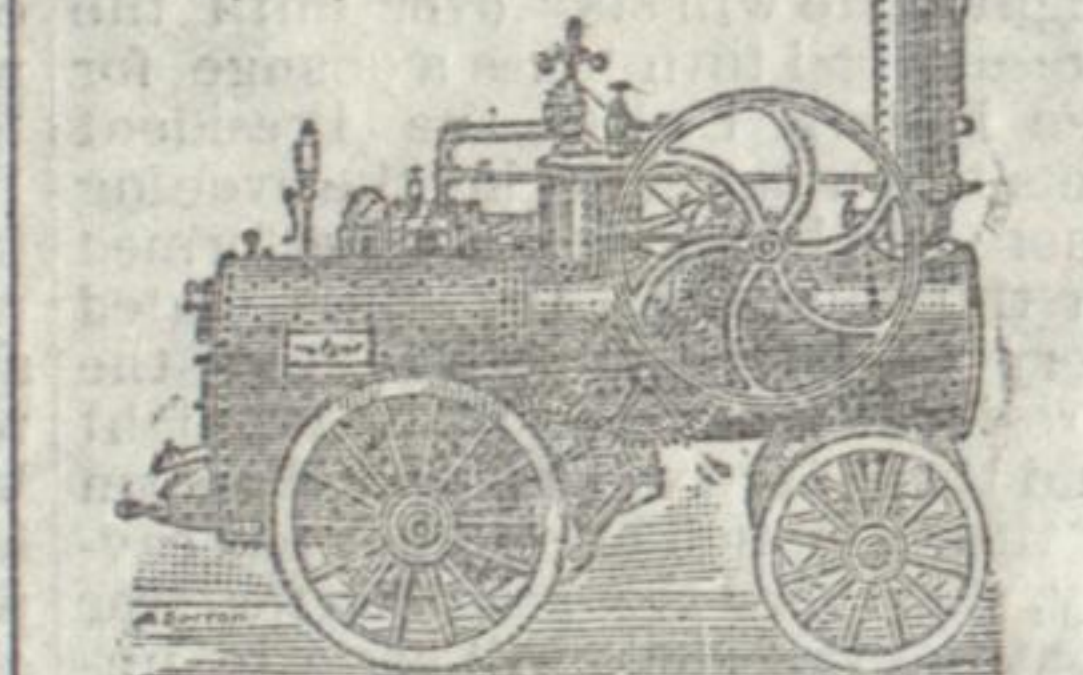

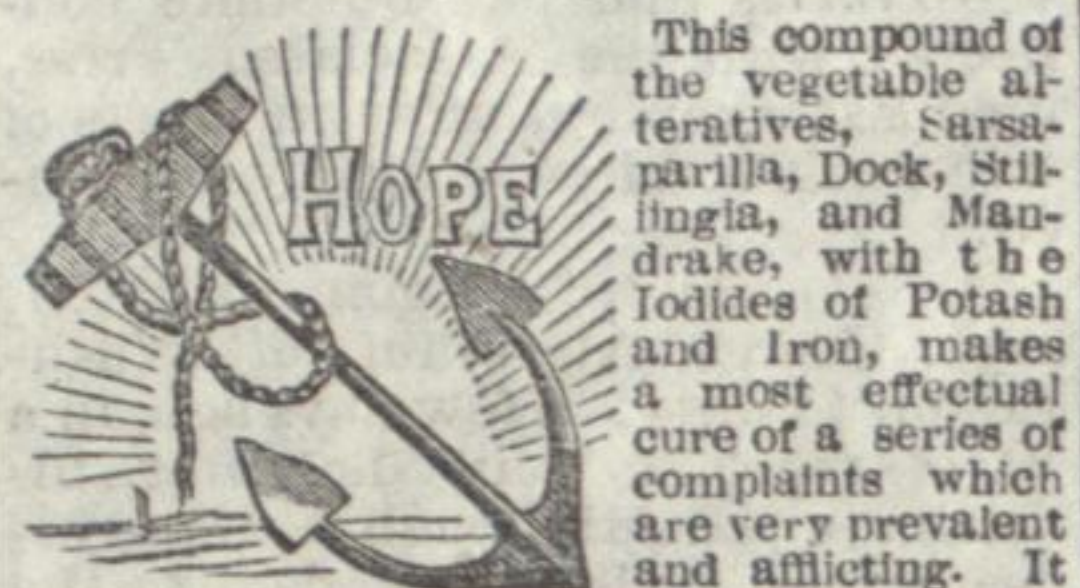
