LEGISLATIVE.—Council met pursuant to adjournment.

Communications from Dr. Durant, Wm. Clayton, Esq. and Hon. Z. Snow, acknowledging the tender of the freedom of the Council Chamber.

Mr. Hyde presented the Financial Report of Sanpete County, which was read and referred to the Committee on Revenue.

Mr. E. Snow presented a petition of Joseph W. Young and sixty-one others, settlers on the Muddy, asking for a County organization, which was read and referred.

The freedom of the Council Chamber was tendered to Major General F. P. Blair, General N. B. Buford and a number of the Commissioners of the Union Pacific Railroad.

Mr. Smoot, Chairman pro tem of the committee on Revenue, to whom was referred (C.F.No.3), with certain instructions, reported the bill back, and presented (C.F.No.4) a bill entitled, "An Act to amend an act entitled 'an act prescribing the manner of assessing and collecting Territorial and County taxes, and for other purposes, approved January 20, 1865.'"

Mr. Woodruff presented (C.F.No.5), "An Act to provide for Mechanics' and Laborers' lien," which passed its first reading, and one hundred copies were ordered printed.

Mr. Woodruff also presented (C.F.No.6), "An Act providing for interest of money," which passed its first reading, and one hundred copies were ordered printed.

Mr. Smoot presented (C.F.No.7), "An Act prescribing rules and regulations for the execution of the trust arising under an act of Congress, entitled 'an act for the relief of the inhabitants of cities and towns upon the public lands, approved, March 2, 1867.'" which passed its first reading and one hundred copies were ordered printed.

Adjourned till tomorrow at 10 a.m.

Dr. E. Durant, Vice President of the Union Pacific Railroad, acknowledged the courtesy of the House in extending the freedom of the same to him.

Mr. Midgley presented financial report of Juab county, which was ordered spread on the minutes and referred to committee on Revenue.

Mr. J. Taylor presented financial report of Utah county, which was ordered spread on the minutes and referred to the committee on Revenue.

The freedom of the House was extended by unanimous vote, to General F. P. Blair, General N. B. Buford and Colonel Wendell, United States Commissioners of the Union Pacific Railroad.

The Territorial Road Commissioner's report was received, read, and referred to the committee on Roads, Bridges and Ferries, and seventy-five copies ordered printed in pamphlet form.

On motion of Mr. Rockwood the committee on Counties were instructed to examine the quarantine laws and see if further legislation was necessary in order to prevent the spread of contagious diseases.

Adjourned till to-morrow at ten a.m.
