WAIVERS OF JUROR.

U. S. Commissioner McNally this morning, on the complaint of Wm. White, issued a warrant for the arrest of Fred Lindberg. The charge preferred is assault with intent to do bodily harm, alleged to have been committed on Oct. 1st.

The other warrant taken out is for the arrest of Wm. A. Clark. The complaint being P. E. Erickson and the alleged offense malicious destruction of property and obtaining \$5 by false pretenses. It was also agreed that Wm. White would give certain sums of the defendant, among the articles sent being a slave. The purchaser of the slave was Mr. Erickson, who when he went to the prison requested him to let him go because he had no money. These men were released on their recognizances. These men, however, refused to let him have all he had given her \$5, which she claimed was due to her, and which he paid over under protest. Out of this the charges arise.
