GREAT BRITAIN.

Letter from the Ozar.
LONDON, 25.—It is now ascertained that the Ozar did write a cordial and sympathetic letter to Don Carlos, in reply to one from Don Carlos, thanking him for refusing to recognize Serrano.

FRANCE.

Speech by Thiers.

PARIS, 25.—Ex-president Thiers arrived yesterday at Vienne, in the department of Isere. He was warmly received by the citizens and made a speech in the course of which he expressed the conviction that a republic would ultimately be founded, and he hoped, with the assistance of M. Cassiniere Perrier and other friends, to contribute to that grand result.

AUSTRIA.

A Public Reception.

VIENNA, 25.—The members of the Austrian arctic expedition arrived to-day, and had an enthusiastic public reception.

SWITZERLAND.

Postal Matters.

BERNE, 25.—The United States having joined the postal union, its delegates in the international Congress were enabled to introduce a scheme for a uniform rate of postage throughout the whole of the territory embraced by the union; should England refuse to join the union, German and American vessels will carry the mails to and from the United States.

SPAIN.

Fighting.

MADRID, 25.—General Moriones has begun a series of operations to relieve Pamplona, and fighting has been going on three days. The engagement on the first day was indecisive, on the second day the republicans inflicted a heavy loss on the Carlists, and yesterday Moriones gained another advantage.

WEST INDIES.

A Mutiny—Income Tax to be Reduced.

HAVANA, 25.—Ninety Chinamen, employed by the gas works, mutinied to-day, but the mutiny was suppressed.
Captain General Concha has determined to reduce the income tax from ten to five per cent. during the current year.

A Fight.

An official dispatch reports a fight with the insurgents at Labana del Cupey, in the Cinco Villas district; a Spanish cavalry force of a hundred and fifty men encountered 200 mounted insurgents. The latter began firing at long range, when the Spaniards charged at full speed and dispersed them, killing five, taking one prisoner and capturing eighty horses, with their accoutrements. The Spaniards lost one killed and one wounded.
