The tightness of money in the East with the inflated prices of last winter and the reaction of this fall lead the latter class to expect no starting changes. Added to this, as they view it, is the recent lawsuits which have greatly helped to scare off the investing public who came forward and speculated so readily a year ago. On the causes for the present depression and its remedy, opinions may differ, as they do regarding the business prospects of the exchange during the next few months, but everyone will agree that the market is rather demoralized just now.

The parties who shorted South Swansea will evidently be made to drink the dregs. Today it went up to \$5.60.

Mammoth was weak around \$2.52, while Mercur retained a sale at \$5.95.

Lower Mammoth remains practically the same around \$1, while Swansea sold at \$3.75.

TRADE ALMOST INANIMATE

Sharp Rise in Wall Street, then a Recession and Sluggishness.

Money Was Steady at Five Per Cent Wheat Fluctuates Upward—Live Stock Steady.

New York, Jan. 9.—Some of the leading specialties were marked up sharply. Sugar and Brooklyn transit rose above 2 points, and half a dozen others a point. New Jersey Central gained 3 points and the railroads generally a fraction. A recession in prices caused a falling off in offerings, and bids had to be advanced again to secure required stock. Trading was almost inanimate. Except in isolated instances the general tendency during the second hour was sluggishly downward. New York air brake jumped 10 1/2 to 1.27 1/2. The bond market was easier in tone, but almost lifeless.

The listless demand for stocks and the disinclination of inside interests to support prices made the bears hold and they offered stocks freely all about the room. The prominent railroad stocks were largely sold. New York Central, Big Four and St. Paul fell 2 1/2, under last night's prices. Sugar, Reading, first pfd, tobacco and the local traction stocks lost 2 to 5. Some stop-loss orders were disclosed by the decline, but no important volume of selling was in evidence. Some stocks rallied a fraction, but others continued downward. The closing was unsettled and irregular at large losses throughout.
