Hill Roads Cut Passenger Tariff on East Bound Business.

The Chicago Tribune today says: The board of directors of the Chicago and North Western Railway Company has decided to cut the passenger tariff on the Hill roads to the eastward.

A special to the Chicago Record from St. Louis City, Mo., says: "W. B. McInerney, traffic manager for the St. Louis City and Northern railway, announces that that road and the Great Northern, its northern connection, would join with the Soo line and the Canadian Pacific in making a rate for first class passenger business to New York which would be 4 cents less than the rate via Chicago and the eastern roads.
