TEMPERANCE VIEW OF MEN WHO KNOW

Powerful Sermons on Greatest Evil Given by Thoughtful Speakers.

LABOR'S DEADLIEST FOE.

Capital a Lesser Enemy to Working Classes: Physical and Moral Effects Harmful.

Temperance sermons of great force were delivered in the First M. E. and Third Presbyterian churches yesterday.

The Rev. Louis S. Fuller, discourses in the first mentioned, while the Rev. R. J. McNeice, Dr. William M. Thome and the Rev. Herbert Hays occupied the pulpits in the other edifices.

The effects of intemperance were pointed out with clearness and the comparisons drawn between the foe of strong drink and other evils showed liquor to be the greatest barrier to success in any undertaking, great or small.

Among the telling points brought out by the Rev. Fuller, he said: "Capital is the foe of labor to the extent that liquor is."

And as the government has sided and directed the relation between capital and labor, so must they direct the relation between liquor and labor.

Anti-liquor leagues are organized in almost every state in the Union. Vast forces of workers are giving their life energy to this task, sleeping, aggressive and most of all successful. Through their efforts we now have a perfectly efficient organization.

Link of Kentucky the state which is known worldwide for its whiskey and other liquors. Out of 119 counties 110 are prohibition. Georgia is constitutionally prohibition. Ohio, where the battle was fought fiercest, is 90 percent prohibition.

"Men say: 'For centuries we have allowed the thing and perhaps always will. It will stay just so long as the church allows it to stay, and not longer.'"

At the conclusion of the Rev. Fuller's address, blank forms were distributed to the audience for those to sign who wished to join the league which will act against saloon traffic.

REV. McNEICE ON TEMPERANCE

The Rev. Benwick McNeice presided at the service in the Third Presbyterian church. In his address on the subject of intemperance, he said:

"This is a commercial age, and if we could give that the saloon did not pay from a dollar and cents standpoint, we would prove them out of harmony with the age. There is \$1,000,000,000 of the American people spend more for liquor than for clothes. We exact legislation laws to keep out the criminal and dependent classes and then license saloons to make criminal and dependent classes at home. Careful estimators have estimated that three-fourths of the crimes committed are caused by liquor. It costs the government \$37,000,000 yearly to prosecute the same. The average saloon has a yearly income of \$7,000. The saloons of this city alone have a yearly income of \$750,000. This money is spent chiefly for liquor."

The effect of alcohol. Dr. Thome presented a strong argument against the use of liquor. A description of the physical effect of indulgence in intoxicants. In this regard he said:

"Alcohol affects all animal tissues in a double manner. Its general effect is to harden and preserve, but it is of no use to the normal tissues which do not need to be hardened or preserved. It hardens the walls of the arteries, and permanently enlarges through its use. The various glands which supply the juices, such as the gastric juice, are reduced in function. The walls of the veins and arteries are most rigid and nonplastic, so that a rupture or aneurysm may be the ultimate effect. Alcohol stimulates the heart and liver, the result of which is a fatty deposit around other organs."

It was formerly supposed that alcohol was insidious from disease, but recent scientific investigations have shown that it only stimulates the other.

FROM A MORAL VIEWPOINT

The Rev. Herbert Hays discussed the moral side of the temperance question, pointing out the evil effects of intemperance, in part he said:

"This phase of the subject is closely related to the other two phases. The way in which a man spends his money has a strong influence on his morals. Also the condition of the body affects the soul of a man. Man is a unit and one part of his body cannot be injured without injuring the whole. We should study the effect of intemperance upon the character of man as industriously as we do its effect upon his pocketbook or his body. And as we see it depicting his purse and ruining his stomach and brain, we can also see it degrading his morals. An intemperate man tends to become insensitive, irritable, selfish and egotistic in his thoughts, moods and actions. He is heavily handicapped in the race for the good and worthy."
