The United States see fit for "national" reasons to "temporarily" occupy any territory. The bill provides that the president, after consulting with the cabinet, is hereby reserved and secured to the government upon payment to the inhabitants of the island of the "just" compensation and of the capital invested, together with necessary expenses for maintenance of work.

The bill provides that the president may, at the discretion of the company or its board of directors, to comply with the provisions of the bill, may, in his discretion, allow the company to forfeit all claims derived therefrom, and that Congress may, at any time, by paying out regard to the company, terminate the bill, and may amend this bill.
