The information having been read, the prosecution declined to introduce evidence, whereupon the jury was instructed by the court to return a verdict of not guilty, which was done and the defendant discharged and her husband released.

A verdict has been reached for the benefit of Dr. H. B. Fisher, but has not yet been reached.
