BINGHAM CON, SUED, The Bingham Consolidated Mining & Smelting company was made de-fendant in a suit filed today by the American Mining & Smelting com-pany, whereby the latter corporation seaks to recover the sum of \$27,200,98 for the alleged non-fulfillment of a contract relative to the amelling of certain ores, in which bilster copper figures conspicuously. figures conspicuously,
