

SCANDINAVIAN NEWS BUDGET.

SWEDEN.
The whole parish of Omsund will probably soon be lighted by electricity.

Mayor Moberg, of Karlstad, has resigned as a member of the Swedish senate.

Dr. de Laval's famous steam turbine will be used to furnish the power of the electric plants in the city of Fins.

A large number of boats have sailed the population in Linné and Rönne. A boat hunt will be organized in a few days.

The afternoon of Halmö has granted heavy appropriations for the industrial exhibition to be held in that city in 1895.

Mrs. Ohlin and her two children, a Stockholm woman, drowned while sailing the other day, their boat being capsized.

During a hunt in Västergötland, A. Svensson, a prominent merchant of Finsborg, was shot and killed by accident.

Nils Nilsson's large farm near Fins was struck by lightning and partly burned down. Sven Ohlin, a painter, was killed by the bolt.

Dr. F. Waldenström, who visited the United States some years ago, has departed for Palestine, where he will spend a part of the fall.

At a fire in the parish of Skövde two children, a 15 year old boy, and a girl 11 years of age, lost their lives in the flames. Their father, inspector Vaggberg, has become insane.

There being no perceptible tides along the Swedish coast, the harbors are not supplied with docks for berthing vessels, while loading and discharging, as in England, France, etc., and this naturally makes a harbor much cheaper and good harbors much more frequent than in those countries, where high tides wash the shores. Only in comparatively few places special means like those in England have been built to protect the harbors.

NORWAY.
The first people's high college in Norway was founded in 1866.

In Nordland the radicals have elected 72 representatives, the conservatives 11, and the moderates 3.

King Oscar has arrived with great enthusiasm when he received at Christiania the other day.

General Forsgren will probably be elected chief of the staff of general vice president Frykberg, deceased.

A seventeen year old boy in Elfvik killed the other day one of about the same age. The young murderer has been executed.

Dr. O. Knudsen Björkby has been given the prize medal of the crown prince by the board of directors of the Christiania university.

The annual festival of the Christiania university took place a few days ago, and was a grander success than last year. The speech of the day was made by Frode Schjelderup.

DENMARK.
Brik Strang, the author, has been appointed recurring secretary in the Folketing.

The cost of the forts around Copenhagen is estimated at eighteen million kroner.

Peter Ole Larsen, of Ols Lehmans Vej, who last May murdered his wife, has been sentenced to suffer the death penalty.

Two new big elephants arrived the other day at the zoological garden of Copenhagen.

The actors of the L'Opere theatre in Paris will make a tour through Denmark this winter.

The Prince of Wales is expected to Copenhagen to conduct home his wife and children.

Dr. Ed. Thiers, who has just returned from Ireland, reports that he has found 14 lepers on the island.

Prince Louis of Denmark, whom betrothal in Prince Frederik of Schaumburg-Lippe was announced a few days ago, is said to have been in love with the prince for at least two years, during which time the high parties have frequently exchanged letters.

Dove, the famous tailor, gave an exhibition at Copenhagen, which was a great success. His single bullet penetrated his armor, which demonstrated its name of "bullet-proof." Dove's invention is now for sale at a price of \$4000 marks.

ENTERING AROUND THE COUNTRY.
State Senator Eugene Ross of New York, the author of the Iowa pool bill, is visiting Knoxville, Tenn., in connection with a "Pittsburg" advertisement of a "Pittsburg" by driving around the country in a car. He has started on this trip from his home on the Hudson, 50 miles above New York, on Aug. 2, driving a span of high bred roadsters and accompanied by his wife and their 15-month-old baby. Traveling at an average rate of 40 miles a day, Mr. Ross and his companions covered the distance as far as New York, Pa., over the battlefield of Gettysburg, along the Pennsylvania valley, across the mountains and into Virginia without going a mile by rail. He will return home the same way by rail. His only guide is an ordinary map of the United States, supplemented by a local guide.
