SATURDAY NIGHT'S NEWS.

The Recent Publication of Emperor Frederick's Diary Causes a Stir in Berlin.

A Shot Gun Quarantine Established Throughout the State of Mississippi.

Reminders That the War Cloud has not Yet Disappeared in Europe.

EMPEROR FREDERICK'S DIARY.

His Private Record has been Published in Berlin.

Berlin, Sept. 22.—The publication of Emperor Frederick's diary is everywhere recognized as an event of the greatest national importance. Official and political circles, however, that are intimately versed in the latest history of the construction of the Empire have been astounded by the publication, whilst the whole German people are stirred to the depths by the revelations which show the real character of the deceased Emperor Frederick, his influence on the Empire and his noble aims for its future.

Baron Hogenackel it seems has the consent of the Emperor to the publication of the extracts, but neither Prince Bismarck nor the present Emperor William were consulted. It is therefore thought probable that the publication will have some startling results as far as the Empire is concerned.

The National Zeitung complains of the indiscretion of the publication. The Zeitung cites passages, and says it was obviously not intended by Emperor Frederick that they should ever be made public. It instances that he crasles there was much friction between the Emperor (then Crown Prince) and Prince Bismarck over the declaration of the existence of the German Empire. It is pointed out as the statement of the deceased Emperor that he was not a monarch, but a citizen.

The Crown Prince then describes the interview as related to him by the King.

"Napoleon assured the King that he had only given expression to public opinion when he had resolved upon war. He showed a marvelous ignorance of the German army and especially of the force before Sedan was the Red Prince's army. He asked where Prince Frederick Charles was. The King answered, 'With the seventh army corps near Metz.' Napoleon drew back with every sign of pain.

For the first time he knew he had the whole of the German army opposed to him. After half an hour's conversation the King and Emperor came out. The latter, perceiving me, held out one of his hands with the Queen's hand away from the tears which were running down his cheeks.

Commenting on the fact that this country must call to heaven in its own behalf, there occurs on December 20th the following entry: 'It is really a piece of irony on the message of good will that this party calls on God to aid the righteous cause. In the end, we incline to prove by it the support of heaven against our opponents.'

While the semi-official press condemns the publication, the Progressist papers are equally hostile. The Progressist writes: 'The French Emperor's diary is a political legacy.'
