WEATHER REPORT.

Record at the local office of the weather bureau for the 24 hours ending at 6 a. m. today:

Barometer reading at 6 a. m., 25.42 inches; temperature at 6 a. m., 22 degrees; maximum temperature, 54 degrees; minimum temperature, 21 degrees; mean temperature, 38 degrees, which is 88 degrees below normal.

Total excess of the daily mean temperature since the first of the month, 30 degrees.

Accumulated excess of daily mean temperature since Jan. 1, 52 degrees.

Total precipitation for the 24 hours ending at 6 a. m., .40 inch.

Total precipitation since the first of the month, 2.32 inches, which is 1.37 inch above the normal.

WEATHER CONDITIONS.

The barometer is highest over the Southern Pacific coast, northern Rocky Mountain slope, and lake region; and lowest over the middle Rocky Mountain slope, central west and southwest.

Precipitation was quite general between the Mississippi valley and the Pacific coast, with thunderstorms over portions of Utah, Kansas and Nebraska. It was raining this morning over portions of California and Missouri, and snowing over portions of Washington, Montana, and the British northwest territory.

The temperature fell decidedly over portions of the Rocky Mountain slope and plateau region; with a marked rise over the central west and southwest, and the Missouri and Mississippi valleys.

LOCAL BRIEFS.

The contract for fire proofing the new Y. M. C. A. building has been let to Porter & Babcock for \$9,500.

Spencer Clawson has been laid up for several days with a sprained ankle, but will be able to be out in a day or so.

The construction department of the Independent Telephone company is excavating on east Third South street for cable subways.

The Western Newspaper Union of this city has bought the printer's supply business of the New York & Utah Paper company.

Carrie Calvin, aged 15, daughter of E. E. Calvin, was successfully operated upon last evening at St. Mark's hospital by Dr. Bascom for appendicitis.

Prof. J. J. McClellan, organist of the Tabernacle, and Thomas Giles have returned home from their extended eastern trip, much pleased with their experiences.

Attorneys B. B. Harwood and David Haigh have been appointed by Judge Morse to defend Edward Mullen, the convict charged with escaping from prison.

The grounds in front of the L. D. S. university have been planted with trees and shrubs, and will be very attractive.

John R. Barnes and Bishop George Romney, executive committee of Z. C. M. I., are on a tour of inspection of the various agencies of the institution, and are now in Idaho.

Messrs. Hearse, Gilchrist and C. S. Robinson of the Colorado Fuel & Iron company are now in Iron county looking over the ground for a branch road into the iron fields, and with a view to shipping out ore as soon as it can be done.

Some unknown person threw a stone through the large showwindow of the National Tea Importing company yesterday. The glass had two large shrapnel-like marks in green, and it is supposed that some Orangeman was the culprit.

The remains of the late William B. Smedley will arrive in this city next Friday afternoon, and it is expected that the funeral will be held Saturday afternoon on the grounds of the residence of his father, William B. Smedley, 371 east South Temple street. The interment will be private, in Mt. Olivet cemetery, where the young man's mother is buried.

There has been a change made in the management of the Salt Lake Telegram. William Butler, formerly of New York, has gone back to his home, and the paper will be managed hereafter by Elliott Kelly who came here soon after the organization of the Telegram company with which he has been identified ever since.

The plaster bust of Abraham Lincoln which stood on a pedestal in the Commercial club parlors for so long was knocked over and broken yesterday, and an Oxford Bible has been placed on the pedestal in its stead. The Bible is plainly marked "property of the Commercial club" so that no one will dare carry it away.

Frederick S. Auerbach, formerly a resident of Boston, has been chosen to represent Cornell university in the oratorical competition to be held at Delaware, O., May 21, next. Mr. Auerbach was valedictorian at St. John's military academy in New York, and is a graduate of the Harkness school, and relatives of the young man in this city are very much gratified over his success.

Sheriff Lucas of Shawnee county, Kansas, arrived in Salt Lake yesterday.

Rev. Dr. J. H. Talbot, superintendent of the Utah Methodist mission, the successor of the very unimpaired Leitch, who was the cornerstone of the new Liberty park M. E. church, now being erected at the corner of Ninth South and Eighth East streets at 2:30 p. m. tomorrow. Dr. Talbot will be assisted by several of the city pastors. The new building will be of red brick and sandstone and cost \$46,000.

Harold Orlof of this city, composer of the music for "The Prince and the Peasant" opera, has again distinguished himself by composing the music for "The Merry Grifters," the libretto for which was written by Dr. E. L. Shurley, a Detroit physician. The opera is to be given by the Detroit Opera House for the benefit of the Women's Hospital and Infant home of that city.

Owners of buildings that are wired have been looking sharply after the present condition of the wires, and the electrical inspector for the Pacific board of underwriters has been having a strenuous time of it in answering calls to inspect properties. The result is a marked improvement in wiring conditions, and much less danger from imperfect insulations.

A member of the courtmartial which tried Surgeon Major Egan of Fort Douglas, has just been promoted to a brigadier's rank, "retired." It is Gen. Charles L. Cooper, then lieutenant colonel of the Fourth cavalry, who came here from Denver at the time. He was here first as major in the Fifth cavalry four years ago, on a horse inspection errand, and stopped at the Knutsford.

The real estate situation is considered by local dealers as encouraging, although most of the inquiries are home people. Tuttle Bros. & Woolley have just sold a \$35,000 modern brick residence, 1014 Third street, to Francis M. Lyman for James Anderson; also a \$1,000 modern brick house with six rooms to D. R. Henry for A. N. Spencer; also W. L. H. Dotson to Anna Hansen, a \$1,000 house, 86 N. street.

Just before 9 o'clock last night a hold thief stole a showcase from in front of Held's stationery store on East Temple street. One of the clerks went outside to get the showcase before locking the place up, and to his astonishment found it was gone. About 11 o'clock last night Nightwatchman Neilson found the case, stripped of its contents, in an alley behind the telephone building. The case contained mounted picture books and stationery to the value of \$25.

It has been found impossible to send formal invitations to attend the National Guard smoker to be held in the armory next Saturday night, and Gen. Cannon says a general invitation through the newspapers will have to suffice. All former commissioned and present commissioned officers of the guard, officers at Fort Douglas and members of the guard generally are invited to be present and enjoy themselves.

A railroad man with a big heart and no money desired vehemently to relieve the pressing necessities of Mrs. Martha Davis, whose family was without the 1 cents to live. He therefore hypothecated five racks of flour from a neighboring grocery store and left them at Mrs. Davis' back door. She was arrested, but on learning the circumstances, the police discharged her. The railroad man has disappeared.

The management of one of the big drygoods firms in this city has made a rule that each employee who is five minutes late shall be fined 25 cents, and there is in consequence great vexation of spirit among the clerks. They claim that their duties often keep them after hours, and they receive no credit for this, and to be prompt in arriving on the minute in the morning, means taking the 7:30 car, which brings them in considerably ahead of the hour for opening up.

The erring young woman who suicided by shooting herself through the head in the Holmes block, was buried yesterday privately from St. Mark's church, undertaking parlors. Her assumed name was Madge Miller, but her real name proves to have been Lulu Decker. She was reared on a farm near Portland, Ore., and her people had been led to believe that she was working as a domestic, and were not aware of her real conduct in life. A relative arrived last evening from Oregon, and arranged with Mr. Evans for the funeral.

J. C. Leary has returned home from his extended trip to Texas and the east in the interest of the new United Stock Growers' corporation, of which he is the managing director. Mr. Leary says he found stockmen heartily in favor of the scheme, and that the railroads will approve of it themselves when they see that it means fairness to both sides. He is concluding negotiations with parties to take the company in this city and Denver. Mr. Leary leaves shortly for Kansas City, Omaha and Chicago and other stock shipping points, to locate agencies.

William M. Sunderland, the original rubber plant man of Utah, is in the city today on business connected with organization of a company which will engage in the manufacture of rubber. Mr. Sunderland has with him some wonderfully fine samples of fiber and rubber made from the roots of the plant. He has shown these to a number of Salt Lake business men who are much interested with the display. Mr. Sunderland is associated with Mr. John Beck who is now in Denver on the same business. Immediately on Mr. Beck's return active steps will be taken in the formation of the rubber company.
