Slavin and Barnard Kennedy for aldermen at large. The meeting was perfectly harmonious.

St. PAUL, 19.—The snow is mainly confined to the southern part of the State, along the Southern Minnesota road and Sioux City east of St. James. On these lines the cuts are full of snow and drifts are several feet deep on the track and no trains have moved since Friday night. On the Hastings and Dakota, travel is prevented by snow. East of Stewart on the northern lines, there is less snow detention to the moving of trains, arising mainly from the disabling of the telegraph lines by wind. Some snow is however on the St. Paul, Minneapolis and Manitoba, in the wooded country west of Red river.
