ON THE EXCHANGEUtah Stocks Lead and Appear
To be Holding Their
Own.

SECOND SALES MARK DROPS.

Totals for Morning Are Light Showing
Persistent "Sympathetic" Feeling
—May Day Fairly Active.

A light day's trading was recorded for this morning on the local mining stock exchange. There was practically no stock sold but Utahs and they appear to be holding their own in these days of ups-and-downs. Carissa, for which 50 was bid yesterday morning, sold for 50 this morning, 100 shares changing hands during the regular call and 400 on the open board. May Day was a fairly active seller at 80 and 24 1/2, 1,500 shares going at the first figure and 500 at the second. Both sales were made during the regular call. Nevada Hill is holding its own, 500 sold at \$3.90 and 400 at \$3.74. Star Con. is another stock which refuses to make any disconcerting sales downward.
