ONLY SCENE OF CRIMES.

The Total Appropriation of \$40
Asked For.—General Recom-
mendations.

Mrs. J. H. Ferry, President of the
Woman's Industrial Christian Home
Association, presented her annual re-
port to the trustees of the institution on
Tuesday evening. It was unanimously
adopted. The six officers were
elected for the ensuing year. The report
is as follows:

To the Board of Directors of the Woman's In-
dustrial Christian Home Associa-
tion of Utah.

Since our last annual meeting, October 1st, which stood adjourned to November 1st, the Church Council has
been in session of its members and
on November 11th turned over to our Association this building.

This was in accordance with the act
of Congress of July 1, 1888, a part of which is as follows: "When such building shall have been
constructed and finished, it shall be
held in trust by the Church Council
of the Christian Home Association of Utah
Territory, to be used and occupied by
it for the purpose of aiding in the sup-
port of the Agency and of maintaining
an industrial school for the employ-
ment and means of self-support for
the dependent women who practice
polygamy, and the children of such
women or bachelors as in said Terri-
tory."

At that date three women and six
children, nine inmates, were residing
in the building.

During the year, from the
report of the matron, Mrs. A. E. Hayes,
the inmates in the Home in December
were eleven, but women and seven
children.

In general writing there are twenty
in the Home, eight women and twelve
children. In addition to these there
are applications for five, one woman
and four children, who are not yet
under the law. Eleven children are at-
tending school. Whole number of ap-
plicants during the month above
named, fifteen. All these applicants
have been granted employment and
means of self-support for the dependent
women who practice polygamy, and
the children of such women or bachelors
as in said Territory in accordance
with the law of the land.

Upon each numerous applicants as
a basis, Congress was asked to en-
act the law of the land. This was
unsuccessfully and finally considered
by Congress and resulted in the follow-
ing amendments to the original bill:

the bill became law, the bill was desig-
nated a Bill of Control.

They are: First, first or legal wives;
Second, women and girls with poly-
gamous parents; third, women and
girls covered into polygamy. Third,
girls of polygamous parents anxious
to escape from polygamous surround-
ings; fourth, persons who have
been polygamous children, and removed
into the Territory in ignorance of
the existence there of polygamy.

I am clear in my mind that the
bill, as it stands, is not fit for
management and control, is disposed
in a final decision, to make as generous
a construction of this law as is possible.

With the burden of examination for
admission, mine, first through the
machinery of this association, and has
done so far, and I am sure, with
others, or a subcommittee appointed
by them.

Although there has been no
exception taken in any case, to those
admitted, yet the law, as it stands, is
not fit for management and control, and
may be easily subject to re-
vision and revision, may they not be
revised to apply the most strict con-
struction of the law?

We are well to apply strict
construction and present for consideration, as
the basis of control.

I respectfully call on the attention of
the people of the state and my
representatives to which my remarks
directly apply and ask for a generous
construction of the law.

It is hard to see how Congress could
have done more for the needy special
case.

Your association had occasion de-
cember 1st to make an application
from the Ordinance Committee
through the director of that association.

The following cases were deemed to be
within the law and admitted: Mrs. Erickson
and her children by reason of
the death of her husband, who was
caused by polygamy; Mrs. Caroline
Miller and her child, as coming under
that part of the law referring to the
death of the husband, who was a
polygamist; the children of Mrs. Wadsworth,
a polygamous seventh wife, were ad-
mitted.

All other cases presented were con-
sidered doubtful. The association is
desirous of receiving all children under-
tended by the law.

In the next few weeks from which I
have no record in this report, the law will
be revised and completed by
this association for the purpose of sub-
mitting an industrial home and pro-
viding employment and means of self-
support.

As a result of the establishment of
the several departments of cooking,
housekeeping, laundry, tailoring, wash-
ing, we have been greatly encouraged.
To a limited extent have we
been enabled to do this, reaching up
little further than laundry work and
these. The only business of the
home have been laundrying, dress-
making, going out from the home for
service, for state employment
the housewife, who is not
strictly kept for the man and given
to the individual earning the same for
their own benefit. So far as the men-
bers of the church are concerned, we
would naturally have these industries
been continued. To facilitate in dress-
making Mrs. A. E. Hayes was engaged
in addition to the laundry work.
To go this way for this department
she gave her services four months
previous, aside from her board. This
is a considerable sum, but the institution
had to pay her board, that of the man and
wife.

The importance of suitably establish-
ing the department cannot be too

strongly emphasized. I might say a
word for the man and wife, as
members of the church will be
the reports of the executives will
be given and less concerned in
every respect. It is this that not
the expectation of the board.

We ask that the usual appropriation
of \$40, necessary for the audience and
other expenses of operation of the
home, be granted for the coming year,
and that this be presented by the Utah
Commission in their recommendations
to the legislature.

In my report to the association a
year ago I took occasion to say: "We
are at the threshold of changes inevi-
table in this Territory, consequent upon
the influence of the new law. This
does not augur the repeat of such
laws or the segregation of any portion
of the race, rather the necessity of the
law. Its existence is part of the United
States law for the suppression of poly-
gamy and who shall say what part is
best?"
