THE NEW U. S. MARSHAL.
Mr. L. A. Bentin Will Enter Upon His Duties On or About October 1st.

Postmaster Irving A. Benton, the new-appointed U. S. Marshal for Utah, paid a visit to the postoffice this morning, accompanied by the retiring marshal, Mr. H. H. Parsons. He was over the entire building, and made himself thoroughly acquainted with the present position of affairs there. Upon his return, at 2 o'clock, he was seen by a News reporter, and asked him to go to his future place. On this point Mr. Benton was somewhat reserved, saying that he preferred to get into business before making known anything pertaining to changes or otherwise in his department. He has been given full notification of his appointment in the Marshal's office, a private dispatch has reached him informing him of the nature and inauguration of the marshal's position.

The postmaster said, "I have heard that the President has probably issued an executive order to the effect that the postmaster is to be discharged on the 1st of October." Mr. Benton thinks it probable that the command comes from the President, who will arrive about Wednesday next, and are soon after that he is qualified and prepared to discharge me." He added that he held the official robes. By October 1st the new marshal would be discharging the duties of his post.

Nash is very prominently mentioned." SAINT LOUIS, Mo., Sept. 26, 1892.

Dear Sir.—The Territorial Board of Equalization having notified the county court of Salt Lake City that on the 1st day of October, 1892, the amount of taxes on real property for the purpose of "Yearly assessment" or "Yearly taxation" by 10 per cent of the amount of the taxes on real property for the year immediately preceding, you have submitted to me the question whether you may have authority to make the assessment.
