A Russian statistician has amused himself calculating the distance traveled in a year by the hand of a printer. He takes the position that a skillful compositor, working ten hours a day, allowing for the time to set and correct, can set 3,000 letters in counting the year at three hundred working days, makes them a total of 3,000,000. Consequently the distance from 1 foot to the stick and from the stick to the galley is 3,000,000 feet, or 568 miles, 2,350 feet makes in all 7,200,000 feet, being 23,500 feet in a geographic mile, so that the distance made in a year under these conditions by a printer's hand is in the neighborhood of 14,000 miles.

A gentleman in Edinburgh, Scotland, has just patented an invention of interest to lithographers. This gentleman has made a number of experiments, which have thus been weakened, applying to them a backing of granite. The material is applied when placed in contact with a roughened surface, and is made to conform to the form with the stone. It is attached to one solid mass. Its capacity for sustaining pressure is increased by the grain. In addition, strength should be required, bare steel can easily be introduced with the material in a soft condition. The material is made in the form of an inch in thickness, and is composed of a number of thin plates, none of them sufficiently serviceable as will, it is said, consequently be worn out. The blocks of the material may thus become capable of furnishing the material for three or four times, while still the use can be turned to profitable
