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While these Northern Pacific locomotives are the most powerful in the world, it may be said that on the Erie road there is one that weighs 275,000 pounds and has 10,000 pounds on the drivers, while those of the Northern Pacific weigh 180,000 pounds and have 12,000 pounds on the drivers but the Erie engine has only 2,435 square feet of heating surface, against 2,721 square feet on the Erie engine. The wheels of the big locomotives are six feet in diameter, while the low-pressure cylinders are within two inches of the rest, or just a little less than the total diameter of some locomotives four years ago. The diameter of the big wheels is 66 inches, and the distance between the trucks is thirty inches. There are 232 tubes two and a quarter inches in diameter, and fourteen feet long. The two Babcock and Wilcox boilers are 48 feet in length, three and a half feet in diameter and a third feet deep. The two big tanks are 48 feet in length, the bottom is six feet by six feet, and the boiler pressure is 180 pounds.

HAWAIIAN RECIPROCITY EFFECTS.

The full record for 1963, which is being published by the U.S. Department of State, shows that during that year, 1970, there was only one small boat sent ashore to the country, there are not enough to produce about \$300,000 a year, and it is asserted that if the government assistance for sugar, rice and flour is cut off, the government and plantation owners will withdraw within two years there will be no small boat factories to supply the Pacific island demand, while the average of \$700,000 a year, which is now received from the Pacific area to the Hawaiian Islands for sugar would be kept home for local producers and workers, promoting local prosperity and yet not increasing the cost of sugar to the United States.
