Fifteen years ago this day was sparsely settled and thought impossible, by reason of early and extreme frosts, to become the desirable location it has.

The timely rains, which had fallen for a day or two previous, had rendered traveling a luxury, cooling the recent intense atmosphere, and improving materially the condition of our roads.

The audience was addressed by Bishop Wm. F. Littlewood, and W. B. Preston, Frost. B. Young, Jun., Supt. Moses Thatcher and Bishop Samuel Beckley.

At this place guns were fired and flags in honor of a grand and a grand procession was formed, comprising cavalry, the band, divers dignitaries, the various trades, and the school children.

A grand jubilee of the school children of the country was held in this city on the 24th. The meeting-house was decorated with grape vines and flowers.
