A TRICK OF THE CONSPIRATORS.

WHEN THE DESERET NEWS speaks of the adventures and conspirators who have continually been in the shadows and advocated the destruction of every right dear to freedom, for the subjugation of the majority of Utah's citizens and their own aggrandizement, it intends no reference to any decent non-Mormon who is engaged in legitimate business and not in the work of defaming and destroying his fellows. We believe the respectable and fair-minded non-Mormons of this Territory understand this. We have made no war upon them. We have not interfered with their religion or their faith. We have not denounced them in any way. We have no quarrel with them because they are opposed to our views on religion or politics. We have always conceded their right to think and act as they consider right, so long as they do not infringe on the rights of others. We have freely acknowledged their perfect liberty to attack our faith and contend against our principles so long as they use lawful weapons. The very genius of our creed is its favorability to the rights of others. We will be found just as ready to defend the freedom of a "Gentile" as of a "Mormon."

"Liberty to every action,
Every tongue and every creed."

That is a couplet in one of our most popular hymns. It breathes the true spirit of our religion and our politics. Our course toward the non-Mormons of this Territory bears out this statement. Stories to the contrary are the flimsiest of fictions.

But this is one of the perennial tricks of the tongue. The unprincipled plotters of the clique are endeavoring to poison the public mind with falsehood, to attach all who may say of their villany to respectable people for whom such remarks are not in the least intended. They know as well as any one that their insinuation is utterly false. They understand their own position, and they pretend that they have the allegiance and support of men of sense and standing who despise them and their methods. And when they take the medicine compounded for their own case, and try to force it upon respectable people who are not under treatment, they exhibit audacity that is only excelled by their slyness and hypocrisy.

When we express gratification at the opposition of such creatures to any movement in which we and our associates, we mean them alone. We would be pleased to see the voting population of Utah of all parties unite on some measure that would secure those liberties to this Territory which are essential to perfect citizenship. We know that they do not choose to join in such measures we do not wish to ensure them. They have their right of choice. We may think them unwise and may express our opinion to that effect. But we do not wish to denounce them, nor claim them as our own. We are aware of schemers who are without honor as they are without conscience. For the latter class we have the most supreme contempt. We expect their hatred and misrepresentations and abuse. This gives us no concern. On the contrary we are always more assured of the righteousness and propriety of any course proposed when they assail it. Their dissent stamps it as genuine. Its correctness and importance may be judged by their wrath and denunciation.

There is one thing connected with the non-Mormon situation that surprises us. We cannot understand why respectable and influential men submit so tamely to the dictation of the miserable scoundrels who manufacture falsehood and perjury in libels. It is just what we know of gentlemen in this community who favor the latest movement for statehood, and who look upon the raid against it as so much foolishness, but who hesitate to express their true conviction, and are afraid of the vituperation of the gang of libelers, and to be unable to say the chains that bind them to their unsavory associates. Talk of the "dictation of the Priesthood," about which so much nonsense and untruth are uttered! All that we need to know is that head does not come near to the facts of ring dictation and the dread of the lash of its literary whippers in. We are ashamed of such moral cowardice, and we have that objection against many otherwise estimable non-Mormons.

But when we express our pleasure at the non-affiliation of certain noxious elements with the prime movers in the operations for statehood, we have no reference to the body of business men of various occupations engaged in the development of the country, nor to any fair and decent person who opposes what we advocate. We mean only the disreputable and conscienceless wretches who live by lying, and base their hopes for future place and plunder on the ruin which they expect to work of the people who unite the Territory and form the great majority of its citizens.

THE METAKAHILANS.

We are in receipt of a volume entitled "The story of Metakahila." The book is written by Henry S. Wellcome, and narrates the manner in which a philanthropic man named William Duncan, left a lucrative position in a mercantile house, and at great personal risk, his life having been repeatedly attempted, undertook the conversion to Christianity of several of the most ferocious tribes of Indians on the continent, inhabiting western Canada. His success was most remarkable. Within less than thirty years he transformed the Indians among whom he labored from the state of debased savagery in which he found them, into a peaceful, civilized and religious community of about one hundred souls. Under his leadership they built a village called Metakahila, and in it erected a church, schoolhouse, etc. They reclaimed and tilled large tracts of land, built themselves comfortable homes, and adopted the dress and mode of life of civilized society.

about to dispossess the Indians of their homes and lands.

Mr. Duncan has recently been in Washington, negotiating with our government with a view to transplanting the Metakahilans from their present location to another place on the Alaska boundary line, from which their village is distant about thirty miles. It now looks as if the Indians would be compelled to sacrifice their lands and move their homes to the new location on United States territory, as soon as pending arrangements with our government to do so are perfected. This will entail a cost upon the tribe of about \$50,000, and for this great wrong the dignitaries of the Church of England in Canada are directly or indirectly responsible. It is the history given in Mr. Wellcome's book is true.

The missionary work of Mr. Duncan is one of the most marvelous in the success that has been performed in modern times in the annals of sectarianism, and the wrong by which the Metakahilans are about to be robbed, viewed from the standpoint of Mr. Wellcome, is of corresponding proportions.

VALUE OF PHYSICAL CULTURE.

Dr. Wey lately demonstrated by a very practical method the value of physical culture. Although the subjects on whom he operated were not of an attractive type, his illustration is of considerable value. They were selected from the criminal class, who, as a rule, are stunted, meagerly developed specimens of humanity. Dr. Wey formed a class of a dozen exceptionally stupid, dumpy-muscular convicts in the Elmira, N. Y., reformatory. They were not idiotic fellows, but simply incapable of prolonged mental effort, and had made no particular progress in school work. The object sought to be attained was to determine whether physical culture would arouse any dormant mental power in men who were mentally and morally obtuse.

To this end the men were put through a systematic course of physical training, athletics, gymnastics, etc. At the end of six months, when the class was discontinued, the men had made a great change physically; for the shambling slouch there was a springy, elastic step; for the hanging droop of the head something approaching an erect carriage; the skin had become less muddy and the eyes less dull and expressionless. A singular mental improvement was also noted, although no effort was made in this direction other than that to which they had previously been subjected. They were able to perform operations in simple arithmetic—division, cancellation, etc.—a thing they had seemed unable to acquire before, as the average criminal is remarkably dull in all that pertains to mathematics. The average marking for these men for the six months preceding their course of gymnastics was 40 per cent; during the course it rose to 75 per cent.

Dr. Wey now writes to Science that six months later, returned to the reformatory and discipline observed with other prisoners, the surviving eleven—having died of consumption—maintained their good record; the mental power developed by their physical culture has continued, and the former shambling gait and stooping shoulders which characterized them as a class have been replaced by an erect carriage and a more dignified bearing. He does not think that the improved mental condition of these men can be justly attributed to anything but the strengthening of brain-centres by the cultivation and development of muscles controlled by the same centers—the one participating in the improvement of the other.

This experiment shows the necessity of physical culture as an aid in the development of mental power. It is an additional argument in favor of systematic physical training in educational institutions. In this regard the method adopted in some of the British public schools is worthy of emulation, especially in the manual of arms is most salutary. It conduces to good health, improves the general bearing, and, as good physical condition is a prerequisite to vigorous study, is an educational asset which no boy can afford to neglect. It is a good thing for our Utah educators to turn their attention to that direction?
