THE ABOLITION OF TROUSERS.

The abolition of trousers as an article of male attire is being agitated in England.

A leading tailor in London has reached Manchester, Iowa. It is a good sized furniture shop, which floats down the Mississippi, gathering willows from the banks, making cheap chairs for the million.

The killing of the English traveler Powell and his wife, in Abyssinia, was merciless. After Mr. Powell, a missionary had been speared through by the natives, Mrs. Powell, sitting in a chair with a rifle in her hands before her, got a spear in the breast, and, flying to her husband's side, was stoned to death.

Coal mines are not the only places where explosions of fire-damp may occur. A short time since a Danish schooner was receiving in South Shields, a cargo of gas coal. The men going down into the hold with lighted lamps, were knocked down and severely burned by an explosion of the pestiferous gas which had collected in the vessel. The ship itself was much damaged.

At St. Louis, not long ago, a couple of rural individuals were walking along the levee. Some of the sewer-mouths were exposed, and a few of the smaller ones were broken down, so that they looked like natural springs. One of the countrymen, who was walking in front of the other, suddenly called out, "Look a here, Jim, here's another spring."

"Well, darn it," replied Jim, "if the water is no better in this one than in the last one, I don't want to drink from it."

Ferdinand de Lesseps, the engineer of the work, has just issued a formal official notice to merchants and shippers that the Suez Canal will be opened throughout to navigation on November 17, 1869, with a depth of water of eight meters (26.25 English feet). From November 17 to 20, merchants and national vessels of the various countries of the world will be allowed to pass through the canal, exempt from all dues. From November 21 the rate of passage through the canal will be fixed at ten francs per ton, according to the legal tonnage measure of the respective nations.

The palace in course of construction at Ismailia for the reception of the Empress Eugenie, during her stay in Egypt, will be 180 feet wide and 120 feet deep. The estimated cost is 700,000 francs. According to the contract it is to be finished by the 1st of October, for every day's delay the architect will be subject to a fine of 300 francs per day, and if finished before he will receive a bonus of 300 francs per day. The building will be square; in the center there is to be a dome covered with Persian blinds. On the ground floor will be the hall, reception and refreshment rooms. An idea can be formed of the importance of this structure and of the work necessary to complete it within the required time as it will contain no less than 17,400 cubic feet of masonry.

"Knox," the correspondent of the Sunday School Times, tells the following incident, which occurred in Bradenburg, Germany. A speaker dwelling upon Adam and Eve, asked: "Where did God place them?" The answer was: "In the Garden of Eden."

"And what did they do there?"

"They killed it."

"Why were they turned out?"

"After a significant silence, a little fellow cried out:

"Sir, they could not pay the rent."

The novelty of the answer induced the teacher to inquire of his pupil why he had given it, when he was told that his father and mother had been turned out of their house because they could not pay the rent, and he thought it must have been so with Adam and Eve.

The teachers made up a parable for the boy's father.

There are very few persons who have an idea of the extent of the value of eggs as an article of commerce. It is said that France alone produces seven to eight billions annually—a quantity which, if blown and strung, would twice encircle the globe. France exports about six millions of eggs to England. The estimated production of eggs in Great Britain is two billions annually, and yet England pays about \$6,000,000 in gold for importations from France, Belgium and Holland. The egg trade in Paris is a very important one, and subject to municipal restraints. They are sold in baskets of 1,040 each. They must not only be whole and fresh, but of a certain size and officials are appointed by the city government to inspect the eggs for quality and quantity, but the size of the eggs. These inspectors are supplied with a ring, all eggs passing through which are condemned.

The medical galvanists and all who have any faith in the curative power of electricity, will be glad to hear that the French Minister of Public Instruction is about to institute some curious experiments, suggested by one Dr. Fogdidi, on electrocution as a cure for diseases not only of the body but of the mind. This was three years ago; in the interval he has seemingly gained a better hearing, and now the Lyceum of the Prince Imperial, at Vannes, is to be made a proving-house for his system.
