

ARRANGING MATCH FOR BAT NELSON

Lightweight Champion to Meet McFarland On St. Patrick's Day.

THE PLANS OF JIM COFFROTH

Bad Blood Between Two Fighters And It Would Mean a Fierce Ring Battle.

A dispatch from San Francisco says: Battling Nelson vs Packey McFarland for the lightweight championship of the world on March 15. This is the match Jimmy Coffroth, local fight promoter, is planning, and unless the Dane suddenly decides to change his mind these two boys will fight for the highest honors in the 125-pound class on St. Patrick's day.

The Colma promoter yesterday received a letter from Battling Nelson, who is in West Virginia, advising him that he is ready to do battle again and suggests that Coffroth see Willis Britt and Armstrong, managers of the two fighters, wired Harry Gilmore, Packey's manager, asking what terms the little Irishman would meet the Dane. Gilmore made no answer other than to say he would do his best to arrange the match.

Coffroth and Britt studied long over picking Batt's first opponent. Thompson, McFarland and Coffroth were the three fighters considered, and for a time it looked as though Thompson's \$5,000 offer to Nelson if the latter stopped Johnny inside of 45 rounds would be accepted. Coffroth, however, considering the drawing power of Thompson with that or McFarland, they finally decided to pick the Irishman.

Willis Britt and Armstrong, both of which would like for Feb. 23 Washington's birthday, but Welsh somehow seems to have a desire to see that McFarland do ringside weight for him. Welsh and Coffroth are agreed that a battle between Nelson and McFarland would bring fight fans from far and near. There are many here of the opinion that Packey is the world champion and the ring deserves and produces a new champion, and then there are others here who can see nothing but Nelson all the way, and regardless of the fact that he should prove to be one of great interest.

There is truly bad blood between these two fighters, and the battle would be as desperate a fine as the game has ever seen.

Nelson will be here the latter part of next month and will begin training at once.
