Sentenced to be Shot. - Fred Hopt, alias Welcome, the convicted murderer of John F. Turner, was sentenced to-day in the District Court, to be shot on the 20th of May, The day set for the sentence was the 9th inst., (next Saturday), but it was understood by the Court and those immediately concerned, that it would not take place as announced. This was done in order to avoid the mob which would have collected and rendered the way impassable. At 2 o'clock this afternoon, Hopt was escorted by a strong guard, from his cell in the City Jail, where he has been confined for some time past, into the presence of the Court. He was there required to stand up, facing the Judge. After citing the main points of proceedings in the case since the murder was committed, his Honor asked the prisoner if he had anything to say why sentence of death should not be pronounced upon him. The latter said: "Yes, sir, I have. I am not guilty; I am not guilty." The Judge told him he had been so declared by the jury, after a fair trial, and that it was the duty of the Court to pass sentence upon him. He was told he could have his choice of two modes of execution, viz: hanging and shooting. He replied that he would rather be shot. The Court theu sentenced Northern Railroad, causing a loss of him to be shot on the 20th day of May, 1881, between the hours of 10 a. m. and 3 p. m. The prisoner received the sentence with great coolness and sat and conversed with his lawyer a while afterwards, previous to being taken back to the jail, where he will remain until the day of his

After his return to the cell he was shackled. He became very indignant when the irons were put upon him, and swore terribly. He to the acre.
