Neelson is Coming.

He had gone to that place to give a concert, but as two of his leading singers had failed to get in an appearance, he was unable to do so. This enraged the local element of the place and he was getting pretty warm, he concluded to leave the place between two days. The friends of the professor, Duncan do not believe in the guilt of the horrible crime charged against him, and say that he will be able to explain matters to the satisfaction of the public. Heretofore Professor Duncan's character has been unblemished and he has stood high in social and musical circles in Ogden.
