The Swedish Crown Prince to Visit the Chair.

A WOMAN IN NORWAY KILLS A BEAR.

A Fleet Is to Be Deployed by the Danish Courts—News from Finland.

A rumor says that the Crown Prince Gustave will visit the Far North during this summer.

Count Reinhold von Rosen, the young lieutenant who eloped with Mrs. Ellen Hartman, the beautiful actress, some time ago, has returned to Stockholm. Mrs. Hartman has arrived at Copenhagen and is trying there at the point of death.

Frederik Magnus Berendson, the warden of the state prison at Longholm, died recently. He was 79 years old.

The arch-bishop recently celebrated his 75th birthday May 27. He is in the very best health.

Mrs. Edla Heila, who murdered her husband last year has been sentenced to suffer the death penalty.

Forty-one Swedish-Americans arrived at Gullstrand May 25. This same day 47 emigrants left for America.

John Faten, the oldest inhabitant of Asperud, Iceland, died recently at the advanced age of 90 years.

A great shooting tournament will be held at Gullstrand July 25 and August 1, 2 and 3.

Arne Wold, secretary of the Swedish League in London, has been appointed Swedish-Norwegian minister in Madrid, Spain.

The import of coffee was much smaller during the last year than during 1900.

The workings of all the large factories in Umea are at a standstill.

The firm Kyrger and Co. in Gullstrand exports preserved Swedish herring to the South Islands.

The steamer of Gullstrand, have appropriated 200,000 kroner to be used for the building of a railroad between Umea and Gullstrand.

Sweden has not savings banks with 200 branch offices.
