REBUFFING A BARBER.

John Drew, the actor, gets his hair cut every 10 days. Mr. Drew has very fine and silk brown hair. It looks a little thin when it is uncombed, but properly arranged, it shows itself to be really very thick and comely. In Cincinnati, one day, a barber laid his moist, cool palm on Mr. Drew's skull and said:

Radium's rays are of three kinds-Del-ta rays, hardly penetrating solids at all Beta rays, moderately absorbed by sol-ids and powerfully deflected by the mag-net; and Gamma rays, difficult of absorp-tion and not to be deflected. Radio-tellu-ry the very active new substance that Prof. Markwald of Berlin has found in exceedingly minute quantity in pitch-biende, gives off only Alpha rays. These were stopped by a sheet of paper but they passed through a very thin sheet of aluminum, and they showed in bigh de-gree the power of making air a good con-ductor of electricity. An electrolytic pre-cipitation of some hundred-thousandths of a gramme of the new substance was placed on a copper plate. With this Prof. Markwald stopped a set of electric chimes, caused a Leyden jar to discharge through the air without sparks, and rang an electric bell by a current passed through the air from a condensing ma-chine to the copper plate. A sheet of pa-per bitween the plat and the machine in-ternuted the current and stopped the bell.
