It is understood that on and after the first of September next, the charge for messages by the Atlantic Cable will be reduced from \$5.50 to \$3.00—plus the land charges, which will make the charge for a message between London and New York \$3.75, 6d.

To clean cider barrels, put lime water and a common trace chain into the barrel through the bung hole, first tying a strong twine to the chain to draw it out with. Shake the barrel about until the chain wears off the mould or pomace, then rinse it well with water.

The manufactories for the production of Venetian mirrors are situated at Murano, one of the islands of the Lagoon lying off Venice. The number of persons employed in glass-making at Murano and Venice is 5,000, of whom one-third are men, and two-thirds are women and children. The annual cost of the substances employed in the manufacture is estimated at \$1,400,000 in gold. There are six glass-works in Turin, three in Genoa, five in Milan, thirteen in Florence, eleven in Naples, and twenty in Venice. These fifty-eight works produce, it is stated, articles of the annual value of \$2,055,345 in gold.

The blowing of soap bubbles is not merely the play of a child; it is practiced by the philosopher and man of science in physical investigations of much importance. It has recently been shown by Professor Bottger that a highly concentrated decoction of Quilla, or soap root bark, furnishes bubbles of uncommon magnitude, great durability, and superior play of color. They are produced by taking a small glass funnel of about three inches across the top, and attaching a rubber tube of about two feet to the nozzle. The wide end of the funnel is to be dipped for some inches horizontally into the decoction, which may be kept for a year without change, and when removed the bubble blown steadily, slowly, and carefully by a stream of air through the tube.
