

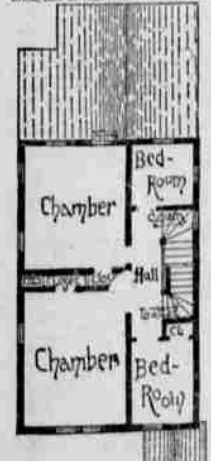
A \$1,500 COTTAGE.
