

Anyone Who Wants a Job, Can Find It In Salt Lake

Wanted, men: laborers, teamsters, graders, rockmen, tunnelmen, carpenters, mechanics. In fact, all kinds of workmen from the man who can only work with a pick and shovel to the skilled mechanic.

This is the cry of the employment agencies in Salt Lake, today, and job

condition of the man seeking the job is reversed. From the reports of the agencies the main trouble today is to secure men enough to supply the demand.

A tour of the employment agencies or labor bureaus made by a "News" reporter this morning brought out the

general fact that anyone who wants to work can find the job, and that the employer is really the seeker. The present demand for laborers and workmen covers a scope that not only includes Salt Lake and Utah, but Idaho and Nevada, the greatest demand coming from the city and Idaho.

The present situation was tersely summed up in a single remark made by the manager of one of the employment agencies. "If a man wants to work he can get all he wants. We are hunting that man."

The greatest demand at present is for carpenters, and the wages offered for such range from \$1 to \$3.50 per day.

The demand for this class of labor is such that it is simply a matter of the carpenter deciding between a dozen places where he will work rather than if he can get a job. Contractors in Salt Lake find themselves handicapped and hindered by the lack of a sufficient force, and the mining camps of Nevada and the railroads through Nevada and Idaho have placed standing orders for all the carpenters they can get.

The demand for all other classes of labor is only of slightly lesser degree. The irrigation projects of Idaho, as well as the railroad work in Nevada, demands common labor at a price of

from \$2 to \$2.50 per day. In the city there is an equal scarcity of men for the work. At one employment agency it was said: "We can't get enough men to fill the demand. Here in Salt Lake the contractors have been forced to send out 'runners'. As an example, yesterday there were two men watching outside our office. Every time a man, who looked to be a laborer stopped to look at our board with the want list, they 'collared' him and marched him off to go to work. We find it impossible to fill the demands for workmen, and the way it looks now it will be worse in the next month or two."

REST FOR EMPLOYEES.

Z. C. M. I. Clerks Will be Given Weekly Half Holidays.

Commencing Saturday next, June 12, every department of Z. C. M. I. will be closed at 2 p. m. in order that the employees may have an opportunity for recreation. Originally it was intended that the wholesale alone would close Saturday, half the retail clerks being excused Wednesday afternoon and the other half Saturday afternoon after-

nately. This arrangement, however, was found to be inconvenient and unsatisfactory, hence the management announces that hereafter until further notice, commencing Saturday next, the entire store will close at 2 p. m. Each year Z. C. M. I. has given its employees a week's vacation. This will be continued as heretofore, the half day holiday each week being an additional concession to the employees.
