CARNIVAL OFFICERS.

TEN MEN AUTHORIZED BY THE CITY COUNCIL.

PROVISION INSPECTOR WANTS PAY

FRANK HARRISON'S CLOCK WILL NOT BE RETURNED—NO FIREWORKS BURNED—THE FIRE LIMITS.

The Council last night empowered the fire and police board to employ ten extra policemen for the Carnivals. A resolution was also passed prohibiting the use of fireworks in the fire limits until after the displays are taken down. Frank Harrison was returned his sum of \$50 check which he had given to the city for the expense of the carnival, and that the amount was paid him before his services were terminated by a period of two years from the date of his appointment and cannot be removed by the change except for cause. He therefore has no right to a fee or compensation. The mother was ordered to return the sum to the city under the unusual laws.

The board of police works recommended that the report of Frank Harrison for the return of the check, referred to in the previous item, be referred to the committee on finance and economy, who will make a further recommendation to the legislature from Wyoming and Nebraska.

RE-OPENING.

A resolution of 10 officers instructed the chief of police to prohibit the discharge of firearms within the fire limits until after the general elections are taken down. It was suspended.

TO DISMISSE.

Gov. Wells and others continued in the discussion of the proposed bill to assist in the decoration of the city during the carnival. Referred to the Finance committee.

MISCELLANEOUS.

The streets and irrigation committees recommended the creation of a fire limit. This will include the East Temple and First West streets, and an area bounded between East Temple and West Temple streets, excepted.

Several petitions for full standing privileges during the carnival were presented.

The Salt Lake and Ogden Gas and Electric Light company stated that it was prepared to furnish natural gas for the consumers. The communication was referred to the sanitary committee.

Mr. Peckham, of the committee on decoration of the jester building, reported that the expense was \$500 and recommended the appropriation of that sum by the city. The council, however, a judicious course was taken on the report.
