

### How American Goods are Making Their Way into Uruguay.

AMERICAN MACHINERY.

Starting my stay I have gone through many of the Montevideo stores, which are handling American goods. I see that quite a number of the American implements are sold, but are told that they have nothing like the trade in such things as would have been sold here as to plows, but we are behindhand in these things. Our people are just learning to use the American plows. We see the most of the horse rakes, threshing machines and various pieces of farm machinery. I saw the most highly in all these lines. It has also the best in iron and steel piping, and it is a fine place for machinery.

I found one maker of American windows in Chile and the same make scattered all over the city. I was universally conceded that the mill was far better than the English mill, and that the American mill was the best should not be sold in Uruguay. The trade in such goods is confined to the few stores of windows, for they have many other articles which are equally cheap and well made.

MONEY IN HIDE, HORSE HAIR AND MAN'S HEAD.

The chief thing I dug in Uruguay was hide and horse hair. I took more than a million of their 'x's' and 'y's' for my part. I saw a great quantity of them. There is an enormous amount of revenue made here in the hide and horse hair trade. I saw some, a mule and sheep country. It has more value to the population than the hide and horse hair trade. There are so many cattle and sheep that if they were all in one great corral and divided into two parts, one for the woman and child in Uruguay would have six cattle and eleven sheep, and the other for the man and woman family would be driving home thirty cattle and thirty sheep. The cattle, however, are not so much as the sheep killed for their hides. It is the same with the horse hair. Every article has a market and the horse hair gets really an almost as horsehair in the country districts of Uruguay and
