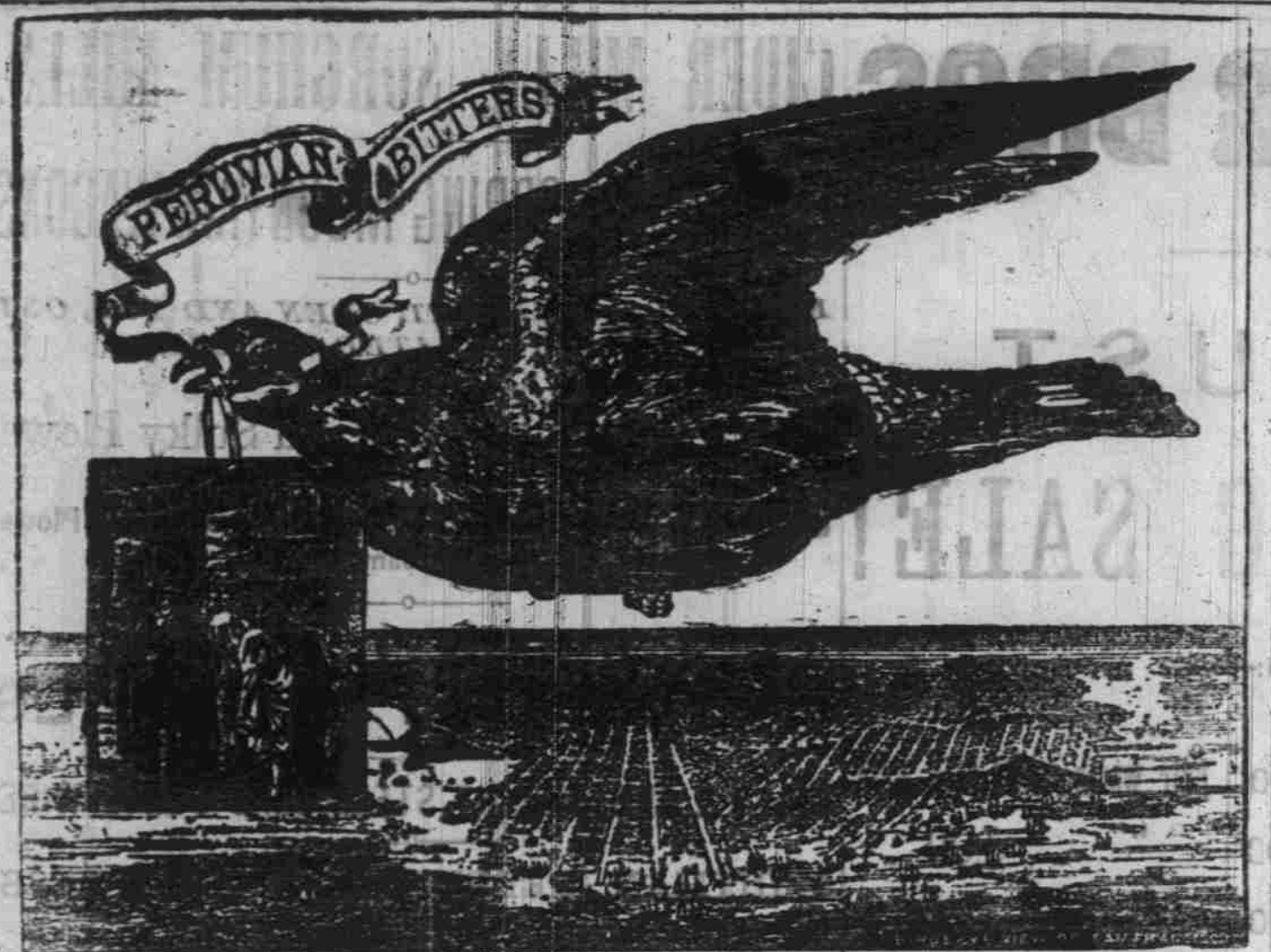

BRIEF TELEGRAMS.

OCEAN GROVE, 11.—The National Educational Convention assembled and discussed the American Indian problem.

New York, 11.—A mass meeting will be held in Cooper's Institute on the 27th for the purpose of raising funds for the defense of O'Donnell who killed Informer Carey.

Alta, 11.—A new man and Joe Telford was lynched by the citizens of Miller county for the murder of his wife, in which he was aided by two negroes.

Chattanooga, 11.—Rev. T. T. Everett, private secretary of Governor Patton of Tennessee, delivered a lecture on the "Men who Won," at the morning session. At the afternoon session Sheldon Jackson, D. D., formerly Commissioner of the Bureau of Indian Affairs, was the speaker.

New York, 11.—A man entered Central Market to-day, walked up to a butcher's stand and seeing a cleaver placed his hand on the blade and chopped off the little finger of his left hand. Before the astonished butcher could learn who he was or ask him the meaning of his action, he walked away and disappeared, leaving his finger behind.

New York, 11.—New York's 5, Philadelphia 2, Boston 0.

Buffalo, 11.—Chicago 4, Buffalo 2, Cleveland 4, Cleveland 5, Detroit 0.

St. Albans, Vt., 11.—A meeting of railroad officials, representing the Grand Trunk, Central, Vermont Northern and Concord & Lowell Railroads was held here to-day to arrange a fast freight and passenger service between Boston and Chicago. The arrangement goes into effect August 20th. Passenger trains will run through in 40 hours.

Montreal, 11.—The American frigate *Vandal* is now unloading in the Gulf of St. Lawrence, and there is some excitement here, as she is expected to pay this harbor a visit after the 10th. The citizens propose a great entertainment for the officers.

San Francisco, 11.—San Francisco is planning its convalescent. Public buildings, hotels and private homes are putting on decorations. The triumphal arches are approaching. The city is preparing to receive the "sign of the cross" proclaimed the coming of the festival. The Palace Hotel courtyard presents a very festive scene. The train brings its quota of Knights.

Denver, Col., 11.—The formal opening of the Atlantic & Pacific Railroad to traffic occurred on Friday. The General Superintendent accompanied by other officials passed over the road and met with a warm reception at the Needles from the inhabitants and representatives of the Central Pacific. This opens up another route to the Pacific Coast, via the Atlantic & Pacific, New Mexico and Winslow, Arizona.

Denver, 11.—Delegates to the triennial convention and General Grand Chapter of Royal Arch Masons, which begins here next Monday, began arriving yesterday. The chapter is a business organization exclusively, bringing with it no outside display whatever. About 250 delegates are expected to be present. F. C. Chapman of Boston, presiding officer, arrived yesterday.
