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## A VERY BUSY MORNING.

Judge Kane Fines the Salt Lake Brewing Company \$400 and Costs.

MORE PRISONERS SENTENCED.

J. J. Gibbons Has a Year for Grand Larceny—Two Years for Horse Stealing—Other Matters.

During the first hour of this morning's session Judge Justice Kane had a number of cases to try, and was kept busy until noon.

The first case was that of the Salt Lake Brewing Company, which was fined \$400 and costs for violating the liquor laws.

The next case was that of J. J. Gibbons, who was sentenced to one year for grand larceny and two years for horse stealing.

Other cases were also tried, and several prisoners were sentenced to the penitentiary.

The court adjourned at noon, and will resume its session tomorrow morning.

The Salt Lake Brewing Company is expected to appeal from its fine.

J. J. Gibbons is expected to remain in prison for the full term of his sentence.

The other prisoners sentenced today are expected to remain in prison for some time.
