**OLD RUINS SOUTH.**—From Salina, a  
correspondent of the Arizona Miner,  
we learn that at a place called Phoenix,  
about 35 miles above the mouth of Salt  
river, old ruins of a town, canals, &c.,  
are found. The canals have been built  
on the ground, from 35 to 50 feet in  
width, the walls still from 5 to 8 feet  
high, which have been traced 10 or 12  
miles from the river. Walls still stand-  
ing from 15 to 20 feet high. The ruins  
are from a half to four miles apart, the  
whole length of the valley. Cotton, to-  
bacco and castor beans are still found  
growing luxuriantly upon the old farms
