THE LONE HOLM ON THE BRIDGE.
This drama, advertised by the management of the Theatre, is a production of Theodore Barriere and was originally produced at the Theatre Am. Comique in Paris. Its success was so marked that it was translated for the English stage and reproduced at a leading London Theatre in April, 1912. The celebrated Madame Clegie gave additional popularity to the drama, it being one of her favorite pieces. Being a French play, it is frequently imitated in plot. The main role of Jules de Lavigne and Dunder, are splendidly worked up and as to keep alive the interest in the widely different paths (from the beginning to the end of the drama). The character of Jules is a thorough villain and his plottings and machinations are ably conceived and as ably carried out. The comedy element is just sufficient to relieve the serious effects of the latter scenes. The other characters are well written and in good hands, and for the most part, the production may be expected to continue to the end of the season.
