They resided there until 1865, when they removed to Ogden, where he has resided ever since. The deceased married Emily E. Newell, of Ogden, who, with four children, survives him. Biley was employed at the depot fourteen years, and is now quite, unassuming man, well known and highly regarded by a large circle of acquaintances. He relishes the poor and distressed of his ward. Sunday School Conference.

The annual conference of the Weber Stake Sunday school convened at 10 a.m. Saturday in the Tabernacle at Ogden. The conference was under the superintendence of the Union, Capt. George Gossard, Capt. After some close exercises Brother Whitaker spoke of the advantages of the younger compared with those of their parents. Periodic school and other exercises were given in the hours given over to them to grow rather than less time to be taught in Sunday school to pray. Remarks were made by Superintendent Gossard and Capt. Karl G. Meier.

An afternoon session the Tabernacle was administered. An exercise was rendered by members of the Third ward school conducted by Brother E. Andersen. An essay was read by Miss Agie Hartley, entitled "Personal Influence," and another by Capt. Karl G. Meier, occupied the rest of the time.
