Cheap Transportation, &c.

WASHINGTON, 3.—When the

morning hour expired, the unfa-

lured business—Washington's cheap

transportation bill, authorizing the

survey of certain water routes from

west to east, and an appropriation

of two hundred thousand dollars

for the purpose, was informally

laid aside, and the diplomatic and

consular appropriation bill was

taken up and passed.

Senator called up the pension ap-

propriation bill, and briefly ex-
