

THE NATIONAL GUARD.

How a Call for 50,000 Men or More Would be Appointed.

UTAH TO FURNISH 340 OUT OF 100,000.

Washington, April 12.—In anticipation of the possibility of a call on the national guard of the states and territories to assist in the national defense in the case of war with Spain, Adjutant General Corbin of the army has sent a circular containing information regarding the strength of the national guard and the arms and equipment of the various states and territories to furnish under call for from 50,000 men, according to the strength of the national guard and according to the population of the different states and territories.
