ing occurrence took place on the morning of October 19th. A girl, years of age, named Hatsu, residing at Ono-cho, Shicho-mae, went to a small piece of ground near the railway station to gather some mushrooms. Her brother, who is a year old, on her back, and was accompanied by another child, who is also a year old, and who had been hiding in the long grass, attacked the girl. Hatsu, however, ran away, and the other child tried to run away, and both were killed by the ferocious beasts. There have been several similar occurrences in the same district.

The twentieth conference of the H. Commissioners for the revision of the treaties was held at the Foreign Office, London, on the 11th inst. The foreign commissioners were present without exception. Briefly summarized, the results so far reached are:—(1) That the Japanese Government permitted throughout Japan within certain date after the ratification of the new treaties, the residence of foreigners and reside in the interior, subject to Japanese jurisdiction. But the law courts composed of Japanese and foreign judges; the foreigners to be employed by the government; and (2) That Japan will only, on the other hand, for a few years after ratification, exterritoriality will be permitted. The new treaties and laws beyond these only Japanese laws will be administered. Within a stated period of years, the new laws of the Government will in all probability prepare and promulgate civil and Commercial Codes, etc., which will be administered by the Japanese courts several months before the establishment of mixed residence and the opening of ports.
