

A FLOOD MYSTERY.

TRAGIC FATE OF A COUPLE ABOUT WHOM LITTLE WAS KNOWN.

The Incident of the Terrible Incidence of Property and Loss of Life by the Flood of Water in Western Illinois Rivers and Creeks.
