FIREFMEN'S RELIEF FUND.

The committee on fire department recommended the establishment of a firemen's relief fund as suggested by Chief Stanton. Adopted.

NEW FIRE STATIONS.

The committee on fire department sent in a report recommending that three new fire stations be erected. One part of the committee was not in favor. After carefully considering the revised plans of Architect Van Renslow and obtaining Chief Stanton's view of the same, we find that the two stations, as revised, will be suitable for all purposes, and we are assured that the buildings can be erected for \$11,000. We therefore recommend that the recorder be instructed

to advertise for bids for the three fire stations according to the revised plans, that the architect be required to give good and sufficient bond to insure the stations being built as specified in the plans and specifications for \$11,000.

The adoption of the report was lost on a tie vote.
