In a series of financial crises they mean the waste of at least 100,000,000 dollars (\$100,000,000). The beginning of each crisis has been followed by a fall in the price of labor which did not cost on an average, rather more than \$100 (\$200) a piece. But when they grew and enough to make up the loss of wages for each year, and for their knowledge they left Sweden, and foreign countries are now receiving the benefit. From a radical point of view such capital is therefore a pure loss."

Terrific valuations have been raging all over Norway during the last weeks. Norway has 600 saving banks. The deposits aggregate \$10,000,000.

The ratio of university students to school children is 1 to 100 in Norway, with 214 during the last century, and is now 100 per cent.

There is a movement among the students in favor of abolishing the law requiring all men to serve in the religious grounds, thus sparing the civil and military service to everybody regardless of religion.

A cargo of 200 thousand of tulips was sent to America by the American firm of L. & J. G. Higginson, of Boston, Mass., the duty amounted to the same amount arrived recently at Christiansburg in Virginia.

The only residents of the city of Fredrikshald are those who are allowed to practice retail sales of beer except by the liquor association and at its quarters.

The value of the ore mined in Norway in 1890 was \$10,000,000, about one-fifth of which was represented silver. In the various mines 228 persons were employed, 1,000 of whom were working in copper mining, 200 in zinc, 150 in lead, 100 in gold, 100 in cobalt, 30 in tin and 118 in zinc mining.

The Norwegian Evangelicals have sustained a crushing defeat, and the waves have been rolling over the entire land. The Conservatives, Christians, and shakon He walls so violently that they can hardly resist a similar attack at the next election. The Left, however, carried the day this time. Republicans carried the most violent exercises they maintained 4000 votes or more than at the last election, but the Liberal and Progressive parties increased their votes by 1000 since last election, when they had only 1400. The gain for democracy in Norway, twenty-five times as much as for the formerly dominant party."
